

Chief Events of World War II, 1939-45



World War II began in 1939 when Germany invaded Poland. Great Britain and France then declared war on Germany. The war in Europe ended with Germany's surrender on the 7th May, 1945. Millions of people made the ultimate sacrifice and lost their lives.
