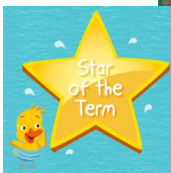

## Year 2—Thaddeus

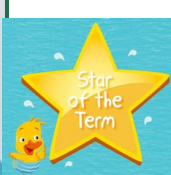
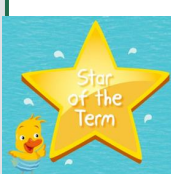

# Attendance and Punctuality Awards...

We know how difficult it has been for many children and families this last term with Covid symptoms and infections around. We wanted to thank you all for your support in making sure the your children are here on time and as often as they possibly can be. With so much missed time its more important than ever that attendance and punctuality are high to give the children the best possible chance of achieving their fullest potential. At the bottom of this page are the names of the children with the best punctuality and attendance in the school. Well done to the all. We hope at the end of the Spring term there may be even more names on these lists. Also, please take a look at the overall class and school attendance and punctuality figures for the term. Our whole school target is 96% for attendance and we aim for children to never be late—after all, if you regularly came to work late you would expect to lose your job and we want to ensure the children pick up good habits, such as punctuality early—not to mention the negative impact of arriving in class regularly late on their self-esteem and learning. If we took the total number of lates from the table above, and assume 5 minutes late, it would equate to over 51 hours of lost learning!
