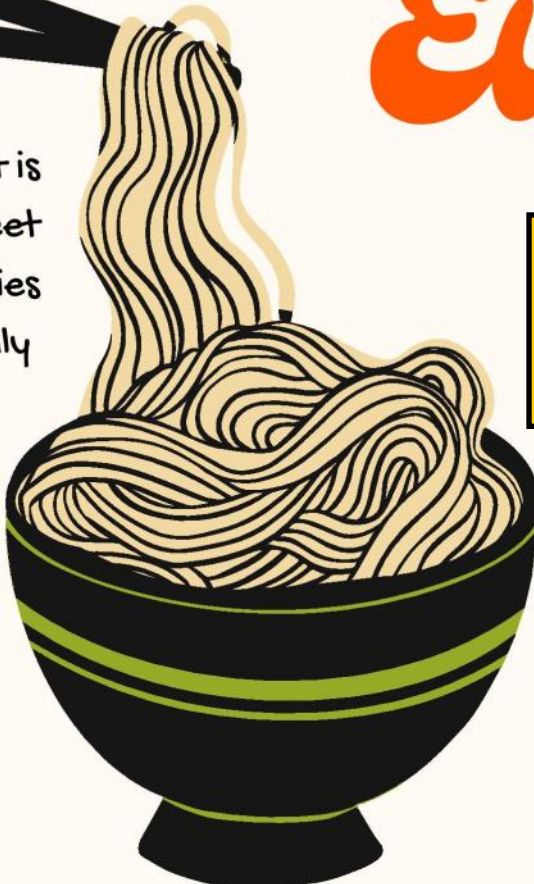

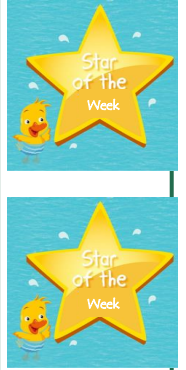
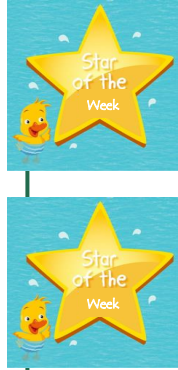

Well done to these children who have been chosen by their class teachers to be the 'Star of the Week' - Well done to all these children, and to all the rest who might not have been picked this week but could have been.

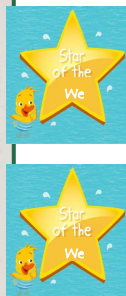
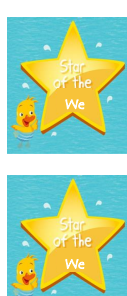
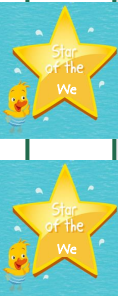


Reception

Year 2

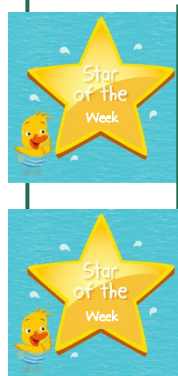
For your great effort in reading this week. You're really enjoying our book and answering questions well. I was also impressed with your fantastic effort in art. Well done!

This year's theme...A Wonderful World!

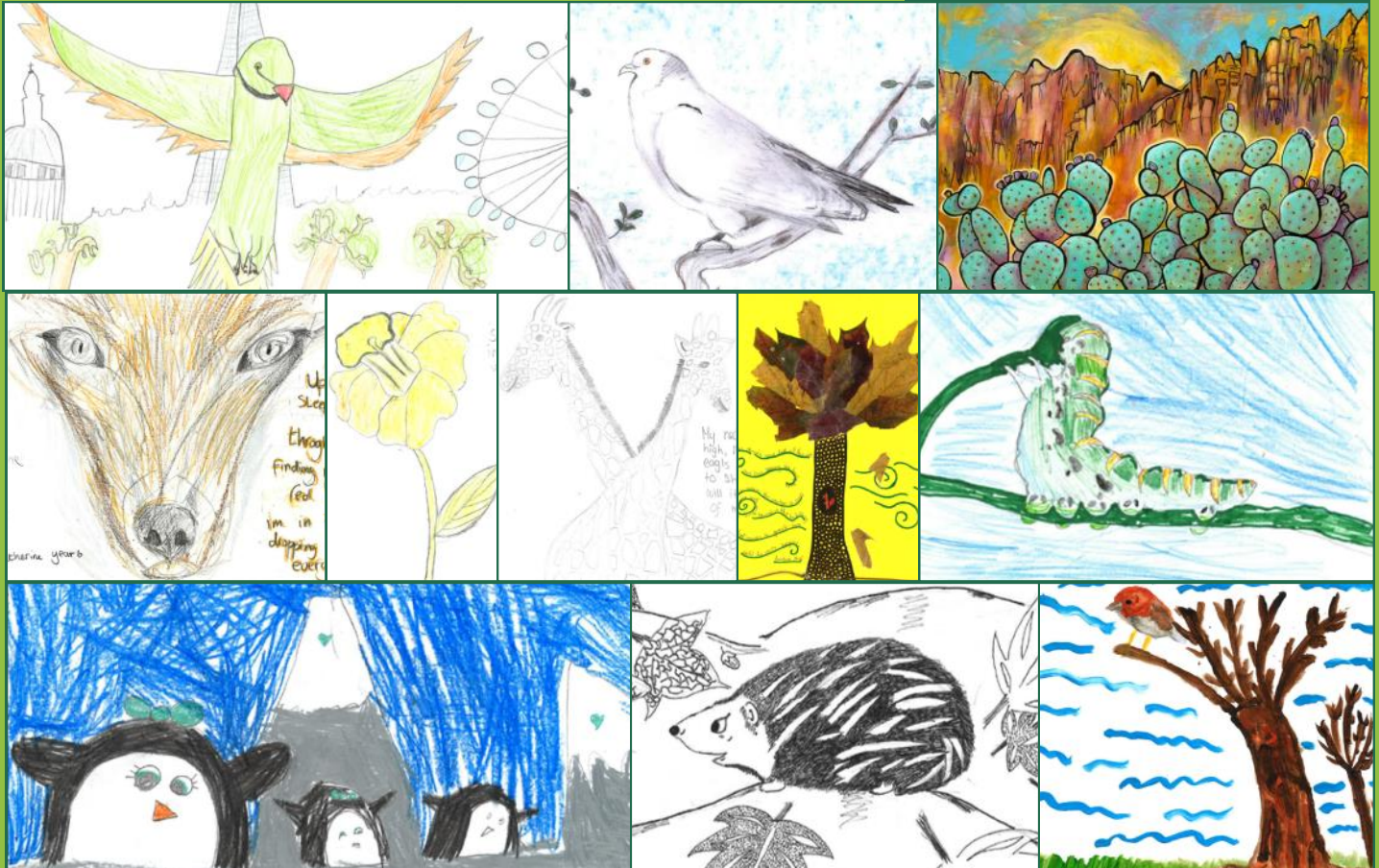
