Fleet Primary School Calendar Competition 2024

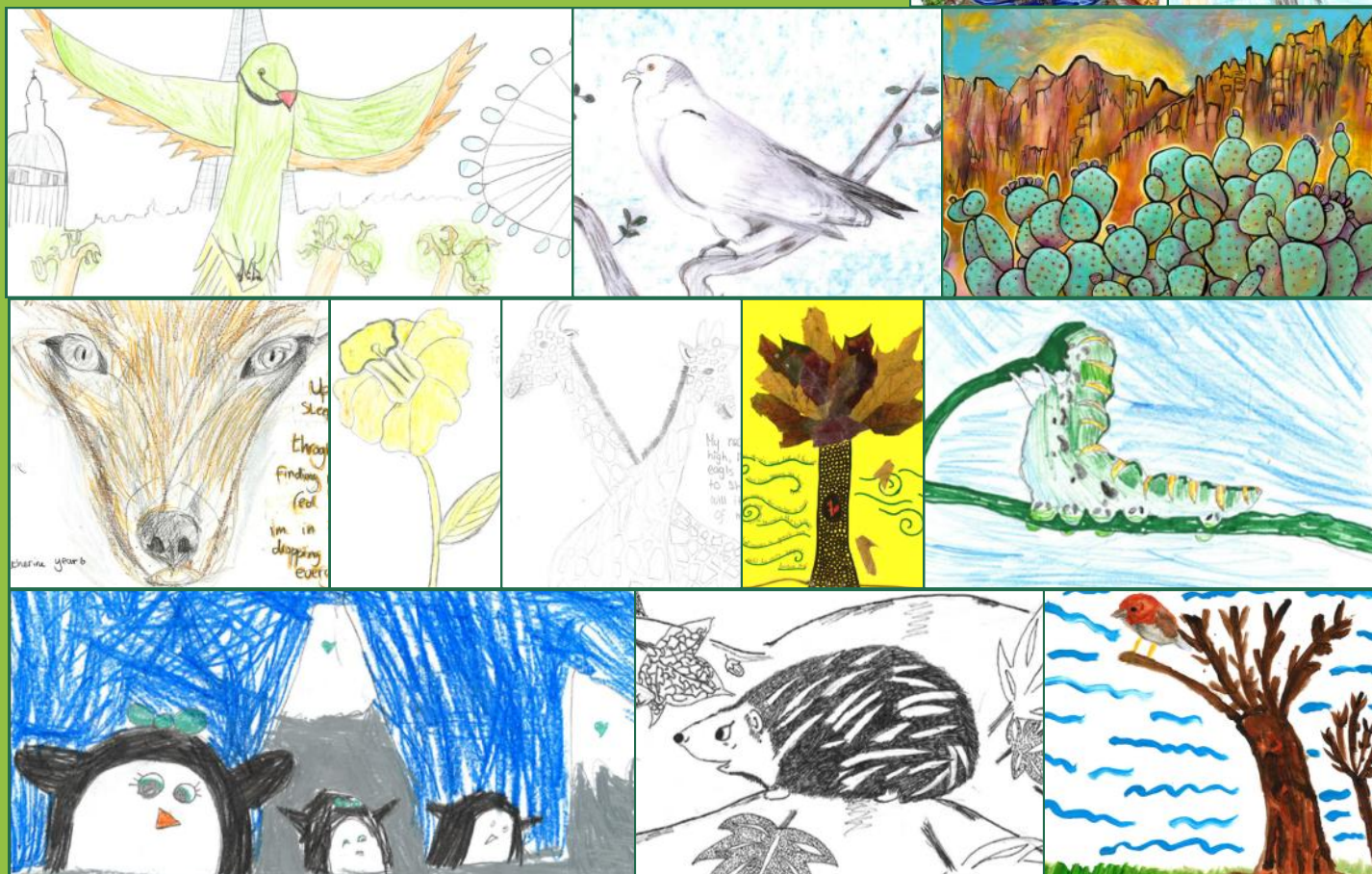
This year's theme...A Wonderful World!

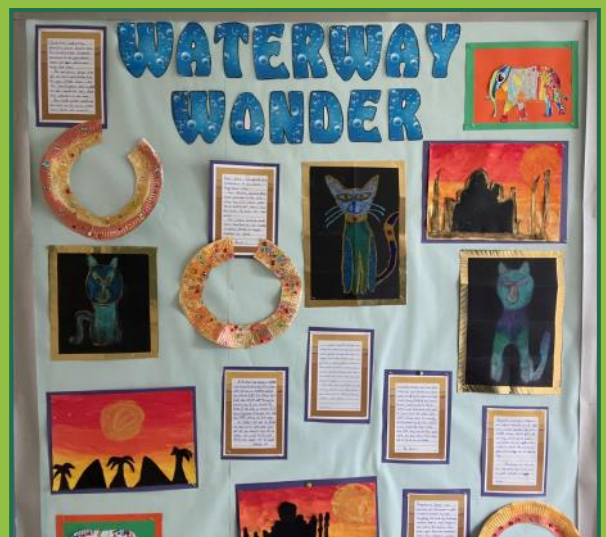
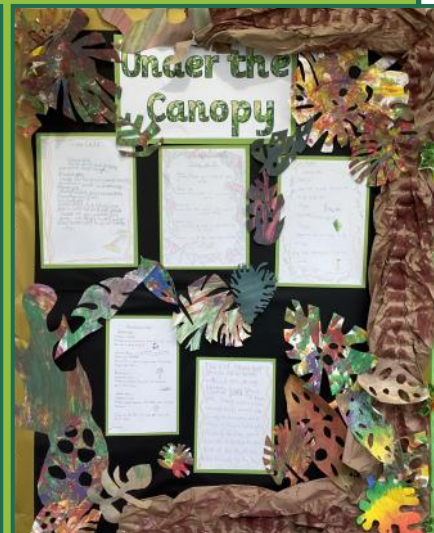

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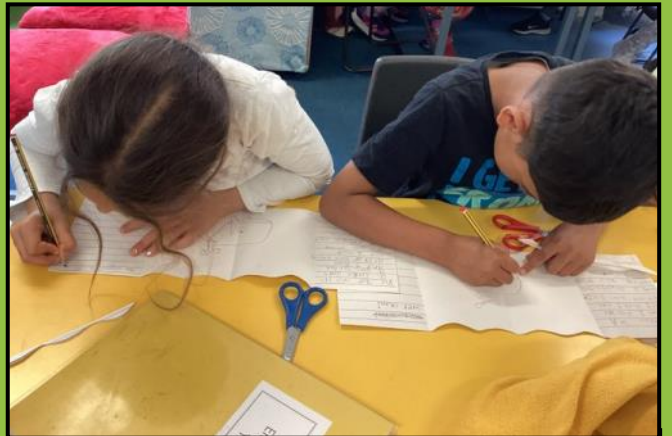
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
