This week our Year 6 children have been away in Gower, Wales. This residential week is a real milestone in their primary school journey and something they will remember for the rest of their lives—I still have very vivid memories of my own year 6 school journey. I'd like to thank my staff, current and past, who have supported these trips, giving up their own time to be on call 24-7 for the week so that we are able to offer this experience to the children and wish them, and all of you, a restful half term. We continue to improve with our attendance. This week we came so close to the target level of 96% with 95.8%. Thank you for all your hard work in helping get us there. In terms of individual classes top spot goes to year 6 with 100% (helped by most being in Gower!). Really well done to year 2 (97.4%) and year 4 (98.5%) who were also above the 96% target. Year 1 (95.6%) and Year 3 (95.9%) came so close too. Thank you for all you do to support attendance and resilience in your children. It's great to end the half term on a high. We have crept up to 93% for the year, with your support next half term hopefully we can improve even more.
