After 3 successive weeks of falling lates unfortunately this week we went up quite a bit to 44. While this is less than we were 4 weeks ago it is too many. Top spot for most punctual class is shared this week with year 2 and year 3 both having 3 lates. Year 6 weren't far behind with 5 then came year 4 and reception with 6 each. Year 1 and year 5 both had more than 10—we know they can do much better. Thanks to the majority who get here everyday on time ensuring they don't miss any of their learning or disturb others' learning. Lets see if we can improve next week—it's been a while since a class had no lates, maybe next week?

Attendance Award

We continue to be affected by illness hitting certain classes which has brought attendance down to 90.5% for the week and 94.2% for the school year so far. Thank you to those of you ensuring your children return to school as soon as they are able following illness to minimise the learning they miss—if you are unsure about when you can send back following an illness just call the office for advice. Year 5 and 6 both did brilliantly this week despite the illnesses circulating with 97.8% in Year 5 and pipped to winners by year 6 with 98.9%. For those who have been ill we wish you a speedy recovery. Hopefully as we move forward we can get back up to the high levels seen earlier this term and get all classes back above 95% as we were earlier in the term and finish on a high in the run up to Christmas so as few as possible miss the end of term parties etc






