# KS2 SATs outcomes 2024-25

A special congratulations to our **Year 6 children**, whose **SATs results** came in earlier in the week. They've absolutely smashed it – performing **above national levels in all subjects**:

#### AT EXPECTED STANDARD:

- Reading: 85% (+10% above National)
- Writing: 74% (+2% above National)
- Maths: 89% (+15% above National)
- Combined Reading, Writing and Maths 60% (+8% above National)
- SPAG: 81% (+8% above National)
- Science: 96% (+8% above National)

And the successes don't stop there! A significant number also achieved the **greater depth** standard – showing real mastery and confidence in their learning:

#### AT GREATER DEPTH

- Reading: 48% (+15% above National)
- Writing: 15% (+2% above National)
- Maths: 41% (+15% above National)
- **Combined Reading, Writing and Maths 15% (+7% above National)**
- SPAG: 44% (+7% above National)

This is a testament to their hard work, our dedicated staff, your support, and the strength of our creative and ambitious curriculum. We are **so proud** of each and every one of them.

# Weekly Attendance Award

Attendance Update: A huge thank you to all our pupils and families for your continued commitment to excellent attendance. Congratulations to Year 6, who topped the attendance chart with an impressive 97.5% – an outstanding achievement!

#### **Weekly Attendance Summary**

- Reception: 92.9% (down from 94.5%) A noticeable dip this week let's aim to improve!
- Year 1: 95.6% (down from 96.3%) Let's keep pushing Year 1!
- Year 2: 93.9% (up from 93.1%) A small improvement let's keep it up!
- Year 3: 90.6% (down from 96.3%) A big drop let's work together to turn this around.
- Year 4: 96.4% (down from 99.1%) Still above our target of 96%, lets see if we can improve next week!
- Year 5: 89.4% (down from 95.1%) A significant dip let's bounce back next week.
- Year 6: 97.5% (up from 92.2%) Fantastic effort top of the school!

While this week's attendance sits at **93.8%**, below our 96% target, we're proud of the effort shown by many classes. Let's keep the momentum going as we approach the end of the Summer term – remember, **every day in school counts!**

- Term-Time Holidays Reminder: Please remember that holidays during term time are not permitted unless approved under exceptional circumstances by the Headteacher. In line with the London Borough of Camden's attendance policy:
  - Unauthorised leave may result in a Fixed Penalty Notice of £80 per parent, per child (if paid within 21 days rising to £160 after 28 days).
  - Repeated unauthorised absences can lead to court prosecution, fines up to £1,000, and may affect your child's school place.

We strongly encourage families to book holidays during official school breaks to avoid missing valuable learning time.
