Punctuality Update: Thank you to all families for continuing to make punctuality a priority. Arriving on time sets children up for a successful day of learning, and we appreciate your efforts to ensure pupils are in class ready to start at **9:00am**. This week, we recorded **45 lates** across the school – this is far too high and we need to work on improving those figures next week - you can do it!

 - Repeated unauthorised absences can lead to court prosecution, fines up to £1,000, and may affect your child's school place.








Camden Summer Reading Challenge Award Winners


