On behalf of everyone at Fleet, thank you for another fantastic year. Have a safe, happy and restful summer





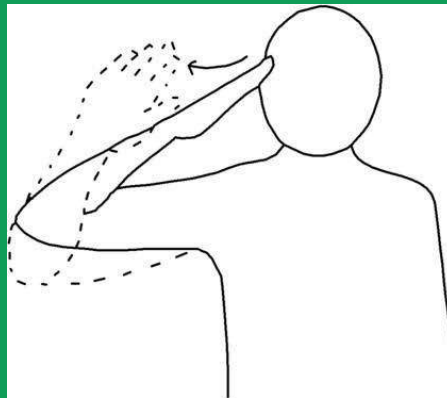
Makaton Sign of the week...

Each week we'll be sharing a new *Makaton sign* that the children are learning in school. You'll find the sign in this newsletter, along with a QR code if you'd like to see more information or practise at home. Please ask your child to show you the sign—they'll love teaching you what they've learned!

What is Makaton?

Makaton is a way of communicating that uses simple signs and symbols alongside speech. It helps children (and adults) to understand and express themselves, especially if they find language tricky. You may have seen Makaton being used on TV, in hospitals, or in other schools—it helps make communication more inclusive for everyone.

By learning Makaton together, we're giving all our children an extra tool to support understanding, confidence, and inclusion.

Termly Attendance Award

A huge congratulations to all of the children on this page who achieved attendance of 95% or above this year. Thank you to your families for making school attendance a priority and giving your children the very best opportunity to succeed.

Attendance matters. There is a clear link between attendance and achievement: children who attend school regularly make the strongest academic progress, build positive friendships and develop the confidence and resilience they need to flourish.

Our attendance target for every child is **95% or above**, which means missing **fewer than 10 days** across the school year. Research consistently shows that once children miss more than this, gaps in learning begin to appear, making it increasingly difficult to keep up and reach their full potential.

We recognise that all children become genuinely ill from time to time. However, this year attendance across the school was significantly below both last year's excellent levels and the national average. Too many days were lost through term-time holidays and minor illnesses where children could have been supported to attend safely.

As we look ahead to next year, we ask every family to make attendance a priority. Please keep children at home only when they are genuinely too unwell to be in school. By working together, we can ensure every child benefits from every lesson, every opportunity and every chance to thrive.

Termly Punctuality Award

Congratulations to all of the children on this page who achieved 100% punctuality this term! Thank you to your families for ensuring your children arrive at school on time every day. Being punctual means children are calm, settled and ready to learn from the very first minute of the school day.

Those first few minutes matter. Arriving just **5 minutes late once a week** adds up to **over 3 hours of learning lost** across a school year. **10 minutes late once a week** means **more than 6½ hours** of missed learning – almost a full school day.

To those families whose children are not yet arriving on time consistently, please make this a priority for next year. Punctuality is not only vital for children's education, but also teaches one of life's most important habits: being reliable and on time. Together, we can give every child the very best start to every school day and help them make the most of every learning opportunity.

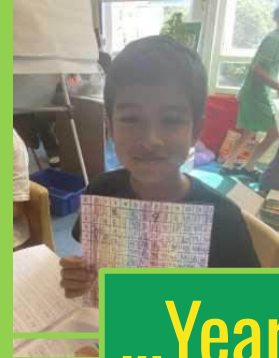

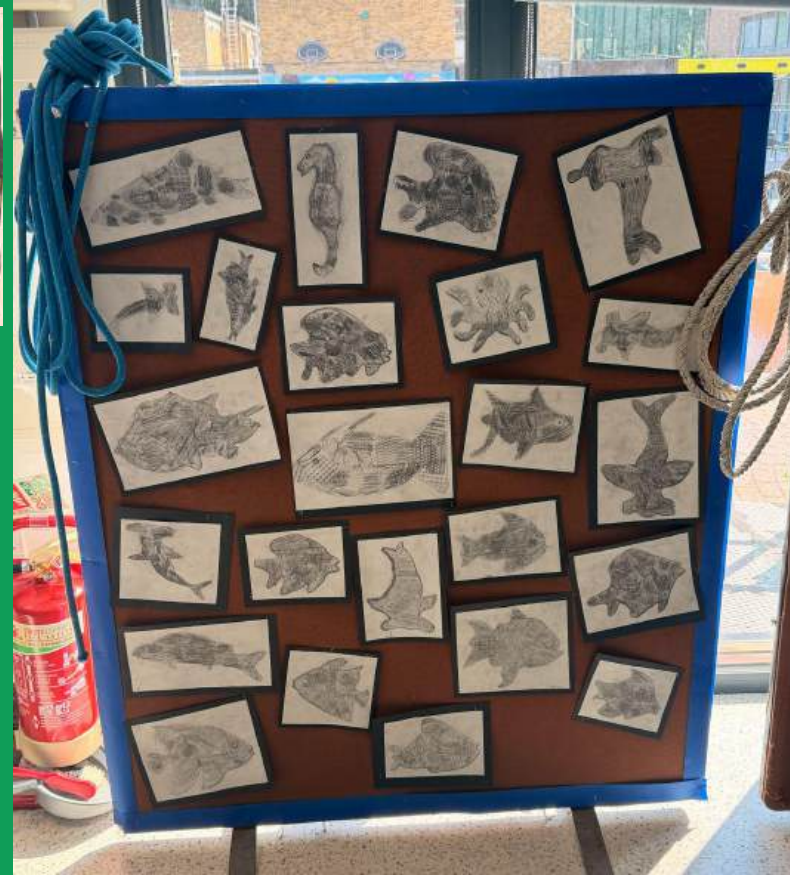
