

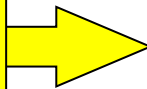


Fleet Primary School SEND provision.



Initial concerns- raised by:

**Parents/Carers
Class Teachers/TA
SENDCo/SLT**



- Initial meeting to discuss concerns involving class teacher or SENDCo.
- Initial targets decided together and agreed on and then reviewed periodically as a team.
- Child is added to the SEN list (depending on level of intervention being implemented) and progress is monitored.

Type of Need: Children can display need in any one or more of these areas.

- Cognition and learning Needs
- Speech, Language & Communication Needs
- Social, Emotional & Mental Health Needs
- Sensory and/or Physical Needs.
